In this weekend's Gospel, people from towns all over Galilee hurried to see and hear Jesus. His heart was moved, for they appeared to be "sheep without a shepherd". Jesus is that shepherd. We come to celebrate the Eucharist, this wonderful sacrament that Jesus established to be celebrated in His name until the end of time, this sacrament in which we receive our Lord, our Redeemer, our Shepherd.
